 were invited from African countries (Mozambique and Angola)

- 10th Conference of the Chinese Ambulatory Surgery Alliance CASA Conference Beijing China September 2023. This Conference celebrated the X anniversary of CASA and registered a high scientific level and participants from all over China.

- 2nd IAAS Iberoamerican Congress 2023. It was organized by a cooperative work with IAAS – ASECMA – APCA and SOBRACAM, online meeting, in 18/11/2023. Registered the presence of 150 delegates and the Faculty was composed with experts from all over the world, mainly from Latin America. This meeting achieved its main goal that was the promotion of Ambulatory Surgery in Latin America.
- IAAS ExCO Meeting Prague 27 November 2023.
- IAAS / My Clinic Conference Prague Streamlining the pathway of Ambulatory Surgery. This meeting was organized by IAAS and My Clinic, with the goal of the

promotion of Ambulatory Surgery in Czech Republic. The meeting had the presence of 120 participants and was a great success with a high scientific level.
